## All Applications Must Include

1. University of Hawaii ID#
2. UH Residence Classification
3. Unofficial Transcript, with current and cumulative grade point averages, (uploadable as .doc, .pdf, etc.,; size limit: 10 MB)
4. Resume/CV, including a detailed list of all current funding amounts and sources (uploadable as .doc, .pdf, etc.,; size limit: 10 MB)
5. One Letter of Recommendation (LOR) from HIMB Faculty Member (submitted by the Faculty Member)
6. One Scholarship Packet per scholarship/fund

## Scholarship Specific Information

Please review the scholarship criteria & requirements listed on the chart provided. Prepare a Scholarship Packet FOR EACH scholarship you apply for, it should address the criteria specific to that scholarship. The online form contains eight sections, one for each scholarship, upload the packet in the proper scholarship section.

Each Scholarship Packet must include:

1. Name of Scholarship, please use complete title
2. Your Name
3. Cover Letter (limit 500 words): include a summary of your statement of interest, brief description of your research project, statement of need, and an explanation as to how this specific scholarship would be utilized towards your research.
4. Personal Statement (limit 500 words): include statement of past, current and future research goals and career plans.
5. Research Statement (limit 1000 words): what your research project entails and its importance to science or management, include statement of need and what funds would be used for.
